RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Age of Cattle will be taken from May 1, 2008.
2. Tick infested Cattle will not be allowed to compete.
3. Facilities are available for exhibits in the section to be unloaded on Friday **not before 4 p.m.** All exhibits must be unloaded by 8.00 a.m. Saturday. Trucks and Floats will be admitted into grounds for unloading.
4. The Society will not accept liability for livestock exhibited, the risk being that of the Exhibitor.
5. If, in the opinion of the Judge, the cattle exhibited in the Stud Beef Section are not worthy of a prize, no award shall be given.
6. All Cattle exhibited must be entered or eligible for entry in the approved Herd Book.
7. The Stewards shall have the power to call upon any Exhibitor showing cattle for competition to sign a Statutory Declaration as to age and bona fide ownership, and if in the opinion of the Stewards, there is any doubt as to the correct age of the exhibit, the matter shall be referred to the Judge, whose decision shall be final, and if necessary, the Stewards may authorise mouthing of the exhibit or exhibits as to correct-ness of age.
8. Feed boxes will not be supplied by the Society.
9. Animals to be owned by Exhibitor for three (3) months prior to show. **ALL BULLS 15 months and over** must have a nose ring and to be led by nose ring and halter. **BULLS UNDER 15 months** must have nose grip or ring. **OTHER ANIMALS** to be haltered. **ALL CATTLE EXHIBITED** must be entered or eligible for their respective herd books and proof of registration or eligibility to register to be available on request by the stewards. **JUNIOR BULL AND FEMALE CLASSES** - to be 3 or more animals in these classes before a **JUNIOR CHAMPION RIBBON** will be awarded. **BEDDING STRAW** Exhibitors to bring own.
10. Cattle from a herd restricted for either tuberculosis or brucellosis will not be allowed.
11. No cattle will be allowed entry to the showgrounds unless accompanied by a fully completed Waybill as prescribed by the Stock Act - 1915

12. Cattle must not be introduced unless they are from a property or herd in which Johne's Disease has not been known or suspected to exist during the five year period prior to introduction
13. Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe, penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions.
Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Ipswich Showgrounds
14. Notice to owners of stock from Tick Free Areas.
There will be no Spraying Facilities on the grounds. Exhibitors will have to make arrangements prior to the show to have their cattle sprayed at the Tick Line Clearance Centres at either Aratula, Helidon, or Coolabunia on return journey.
15. Cattle must be unloaded and loaded within the showgrounds and must remain on the grounds until the completion of the Grand Parade.
16. The Chief Steward has the power to remove an animal from the judging ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
17. **NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM**
PIC # QJIW1193
All cattle travelling to the Ipswich Showgrounds MUST have an NLIS device applied before leaving property of origin (this includes calves).
All cattle present at a Show must have the individual identifications read and the movements to and from the site recorded on the showgrounds Property Identification Code (PIC) in the database.
On Arrival
On arrival at the Ipswich Showgrounds the exhibitor is to present all animals' NLIS number(s) (this is the visual number on the NLIS device or the electronic number read by a device reader) to have the NLIS device read at a designated time and place.
Supply the PIC of the property the animals are last registered to.
Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/waybill number.
On Departure
Supply any animal's NLIS number(s) that are different from arrival.
The PIC where the animals will return to.
Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/waybill number.

N.B. Junior Champion Ribbon will only be awarded at the discretion of the Judge and Chief Steward, where numbers warrant.
