1. Entries must be the product of the person entering. Couples may enter jointly or individually.
2. All care will be taken with entries but no responsibility will be accepted.
3. Special entry labels are available with entry forms supplied, with fee payment of \$1 per bottle. Up to 3 (three) bottles per class accepted..
4. All entries must be submitted and will be judged at room temperature.
5. Judges will be members of the Amateur Wine/Beermakers Queensland Guild Judges or suitably qualified persons appointed by that body. No person shall judge any class wherein a member of his or her household has entered beer.
6. Each bottle to be 750ml will be sealed with a new, clean, unbranded gold seal cap.
7. All beers should present a reasonable lasting head.
- 7a. All beers must be degassed before entry
8. Details on the entry form should correspond with data on the entry label. The "entry no." will be allocated randomly at the point of entry.
9. All entries will be judged on presentation as well as contents.
10. The decisions of the judges and arbitrator are final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
11. Beers entered out of class will be re-classed unless previously judged.
12. The airspace should measure 4.5 to 6.5 (approx. 2") from the top of the bottle.

5. If using branded beer bottles apply label on opposite side of brand.
6. Attach labels as above diagram.

Rules and Conditions:

2. Any non-toxic fruit, vegetables or herbs etc. are permitted as the basis for wines.
3. All care will be taken with entries but no responsibility will be accepted.
4. Special entry labels are available with entry forms supplied, with fee payment of \$1-00 per bottle. Up to 3 (three) bottles per class accepted.
5. All entries must be submitted and will be judged at room temperature.
6. Judges will be members of the Amateur Wine/Beermakers Queensland Guild of Judges or suitably qualified persons appointed by that body. No person shall judge any class wherein a member of his or her household has entered wine.
7. Wine must be in an authentic transparent wine bottle and an approved plastic stopper of single colour. **NON SCREW TOP BOTTLES ONLY.**
8. Details on the entry form should correspond with data on the entry label. The "entry no." will be allocated randomly at point of entry.
9. All entries will be judged on presentation as well as contents.
10. The decision of the Judges and arbitrator are final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
11. Wines entered out of class will be re-classed unless previously judged.
12. Fill level – Wine to come at least into the neck of the bottle (approx 2") from the bottom of the cork.
13. **Melomel and Mead to be entered in Apiculture Section (Section 11) and will still be judged by the Amateur Wine/Beer Makers Guild of judges. Separate entry form to be used .**
