GROUP 'A' CLASS

1. Street Ute

True to make with customising (incl. painting, lowering, exhaust, engine, wheels); added accessories (incl. Sound system, visual system and body kit); interior and exterior presentation; history of Ute (built or bought); overall presentation of vehicle. (**NO** running lights or overhead lights, bull bars or nudge bars).

2. B & S Ute

Best representative, evidence of having attended a B & S Ball (badges, stickers etc); added accessories (bull bars, nudge bars, driving lights, spotlights, flags, aerials etc); interior and exterior presentation, history of Ute (built or bought), overall presentation of vehicle, may incorporate other Classes.

3. Chicks Ute

Best presented female owner Ute. True to make, added accessories, interior and exterior presentation, history of Ute (built or bought), overall presentation of vehicle with feminine touches.

GROUP 'B' CLASS

4. 4 x 4 Ute

Best representation of 4 x 4 Ute's, in constant use or part time 4 wheel drive, accessories added, interior and exterior presentation and overall presentation of vehicle.

5. Work Ute

All makes and models, toolboxes, accessories, signage etc.

6. Feral Ute

The real character Ute's dings and dents and all, with stickers, accessories, bulbar, antennae or remnants thereof.

The Competition has been divided into two (2) groups, GROUP 'A' and GROUP 'B' as shown above. Whilst entrants in each Class will be judged individually using a standard judging sheet, an overall winner ONLY will be selected from the Group to proceed to the Sub-Chamber Final. Sub-Chamber finals will be held at eleven (11) selected centres around the State based on the geographic boundaries of the Societies. Winners from the local Shows proceeding to Sub-Chamber Finals will compete under the same format, i.e. winners ONLY from Groups 'A' and 'B' will proceed to the State Final held in Brisbane at the RNA Exhibition held in August.

Please note if you are already the winner of a Group A or B category for another Show Society you can NOT win in these categories again.
