CONDITIONS

1. All Birds must be benched at the Showgrounds before 8 a.m. on Thursday, May 6. If an Exhibitor so desires he can stage his exhibits on Wednesday between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m. This section will close on Saturday May 8 at 4 p.m., after which birds may be removed. Preferred Birds collection on Sunday morning from 8am.
2. Exhibitors must produce receipt for Entry Fee to secure admission on Thursday for the purpose of staging exhibits, also on Saturday after 4 p.m. for their removal. Only the Owner or his representative will be admitted.
3. Exhibitors must provide drinkers and sufficient seed for duration of the Show.
4. Canaries may be staged in Box Type or Wire Cages with plain canary seed on floor.
5. Budgerigars to be staged in Box Type Cages with white interiors. Seed mixture suitable for Budgerigars on floor.
6. Finches to be staged in Box Type Cages with white interior and Finch Mix seed on floor.
7. Parrot cages to have seed on floor suitable for variety.
8. Neophemas to be staged in Box Type Cages, with suitable seed on floor.
9. All Cages are to be type approved by the various Societies, complete with drinker attached and must be in clean condition.
10. For the benefit of Exhibitors all birds will be protected from the public by a wire netting barrier.
11. Any Bird showing signs of sickness will be removed from the Show Bench and be cared for by an experienced steward/breeder.
12. The Society will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss, misdelivery or any damage of birds, cages or equipment in this Section.
13. All absent entries must be recorded and exhibitor must have birds checked out - **No Exceptions.**
14. Exhibitors eligible for Budgerigar Novice Awards must be approved by the Chief Steward.
15. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.
16. Purchased birds may be shown in all classes.
17. **SALES OF BIRDS.** Indicate on Entry Form or to Chief Steward whether Bird or Birds are for sale and price. A 10% Commission shall be retained by the Society.
